Capitol Spotlight:

Session started on January 9 and the republicans are in the minority. This year the CCC is not pushing legislation. Our goal is to watch other bills and if they are not good for construction and small businesses to educate and advocate against them or try to change them or support our industry partners with bills that are good for CCC or have no impact.

- The National Chapter of the American Subcontractor's Association ("ASA") is helping Washington state which is going to run a retainage bill and they have requested help from our organization in Colorado since we were successful at getting a retainage bill passed in 2022.
- This year we are trying something new by preparing a monthly newsletter for the legislators to let them know who the CCC is and issues that are important to us.
