ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
COLORADO SUBCONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION

The undersigned, of lawful age, do hereby associate themselves together to form a corporation not for profit, under and pursuant to the Colorado Nonprofit Corporation Act, and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be:
COLORADO SUBCONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- A. To deal with trade and promotional problems of subcontractors of the building construction industry in the State of Colorado.
- B. To act as a trade association for its members and, as such, to perform for its members those services which can better be performed as a group than separately.
- C. To cooperate with general contractors, architects and other segments of the building construction industry and their associations, with existing associations of subcontractors, and with organizations representing the building trade and all lawful matters of interest to the building construction industry.
- D. To do any and all lawful acts and things to help the building construction industry better serve the public; to promote any legitimate common interest of its members.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation is organized as a nonprofit corporation pursuant to the Colorado Nonprofit Corporation Act and Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code. It shall function as a chapter of the American Subcontractors Association. No part of any income or assets of this corporation shall be distributed or allowed to inure to the benefit of any individual for any purpose other than those for which this corporation is organized. Upon dissolution or liquidation, all assets of the corporation shall, after the payment of its liabilities, be paid over to an organization which itself is tax-exempt under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended.

ARTICLE V

The address of the initial registered office of this corporation is: 877 Wyandot Street, Denver, Colorado 80204. The name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at such address is: C. Dean Roberts. (Denver County)

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The number and qualifications of the Directors shall be fixed by the By-Laws. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of 7 members and the names and addresses of such directors who shall serve for the first year of existence or until the successors shall have been elected and qualified are as follows:

ARTICLE VIII

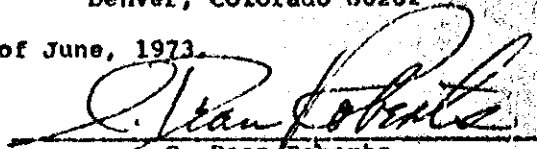
These Articles of Incorporation or any part thereof may be amended at any time and in the manner or respect permitted or provided by the Colorado Nonprofit Corporation Act.
